Length of Circuit/Turns: Full course, 3.27 miles/18-turn road course
Track Cutouts: Indicated with orange paint on the guardrail.
Race Direction: Clockwise
Pole Position: Drivers Right
Start & Finish Line: Start/Finish, Front Straight
Beacon Location: Drivers Right
Pit Lane Speed: 40 mph. Determined by Pit Lane Speed Limit judges located in pit lane.
Parc Fermè: Typically, Parc Fermè conditions exist after qualifying and races. This condition exists either at the team trailers or impound. If not utilizing a parc fermé area, all cars must be outside team tents and fully visible. Parc Fermè condition will be lifted with communication from a SCCA Pro Racing Official via radio or WhatsApp message.
Tech Checks & Scales: SCCA Pro Racing Trailer
Tire Marking: Tire marking will only be done at the SCCA Series trailer.
Tech Access: Teams are reminded that only one team member may be present in SCCA Tech during Parc Fermè. Please do NOT enter the SCCA Pro Trailer.



Traffic Flow






