

Subject: Reducing ECU temperature

Beginning at VIR, Ligier has provided spacers which, when installed between the tub and the inlet duct in the right sidepod, have been shown to decrease ECU temperatures and reduce the risk of the ECU shutting down the engine during pace laps or on pit lane.

Effective immediately, these may be installed as an optional update for the remainder of the 2020 season events at Sebring, Homestead, and COTA. The spacers are available at the Ligier trailer.

Removing the foam surrounding the ECU has also been shown to decrease ECU temperatures. Teams are permitted to do so.
